It is represented by the Doctor Véronique BOUTÉ, its President.

In an apolitical conception, the aim is to generate exchanges in order to contribute to the promotion, research, education and expansion of Multidisciplinary Senology.

"Astarté" encourages women's support. Its territoriality includes France, Mediterranean countries, Near East countries, Minor and Central Asia countries and also Sub-Saharan Africa countries.

The association develops its actions throughout an important network of correspondents implemented and also throughout many agreements of institutional and associative partnership.

The Association is committed through 5 objectives below:

- Demystify breast diseases with women and introduce them to the culture of early diagnosis (auto palpation- Self Examination- and quality mammography)

- Establish guidelines and adapted diagnostic and surgical minimum recommendations
- Form the suppliers of public/private health and involve them in the management of this type of disease
- Inform about the early diagnostic of breast cancer, treatments, psychological and social follow-up, quality of women's life before and after the disease
- sensitize the decision makers to the breast cancer concern

As part of its commitments, a Co-publication Astarté and UNESCO will be presented in October 2019: "Ethical issues in Senology". The provided document will be destined to political decision makers and health staff in 4 languages.

Astarté aims to improve the management and quality of life of patients before and after the disease. Astarté supports and gathers women in the fight against breast cancer while focusing on information. The Astarté instances consist of the Office, the Board of Directors, the General Assembly, Scientific Council of Women Council and an Ethics watch committee.
